Trustee Recognition

The following organizations were selected by Katherine A. Lutey and were awarded in her honor to recognize her years of service on The Kresge Foundation Board of Trustees.

The human-service agency operates a variety of safety-net programs that furnish food and shelter; counseling, educational, and employment services; and emergency financial assistance to low-income, homeless, and vulnerable families and individuals living in the Pontiac area. Kresge's grant will help fund the center's general operations and support facility improvements.
