

Environmental Footprint of this Report

This entire annual report is printed on Neenah Conservation® which is made from 100 percent post-consumer fiber and processed without chlorine which saves 212 trees, 5,861 lbs. of solid waste, 96,531 gallons of water, and 20,043 lbs. of emissions compared to using virgin fiber paper.*

The soy and vegetable oil-based inks used to print the report are 91 percent free of volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

The printer, University Lithoprinters, is a Michigan member of the Great Printer Project, a national, cooperative effort to make pollution prevention a standard practice in the lithographic printing industry.

Both the paper manufacturer and the printer are chain-of-custody certified by the Forest Stewardship Council™.
