## Then & Now

Sebastian Kresge's wish to promote human progress has been expressed through support for worthy organizations. Although we are a national philanthropy, we have always attended to the place our founder based his business and made his home. Since 1924, the foundation has invested \$3 billion\* in Detroit organizations, institutions and the people they serve. More than 1,150 grants have been made in the city proper, more still in the metropolitan area. This is a sample. Many of these organizations have received multiple grants over the years.
