APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Once logged in, you will find yourself at The Kresge Foundation Portal homepage. On the top left column, under the “Information” section, please click on “Grant Opportunities.”

You will be directed to the Grant Opportunities page. At the bottom of the page, click on “Start a new grant RFP.”

The following RFPs (requests for proposals) are open to receive applications.

The Narrative portion can be submitted via written or video response, simply follow the prompts.

The first question you will be asked is whether the application is a fiscal sponsorship or collaborative application. Please note if you click Collaborative, you will need to provide the list of organizations collaborating on this project in the corresponding box that appears. If you are unsure which to select, please refer to the guidelines on our website.

If you decide to submit a written response to the Narrative Questions, you will see the following:

1. How has your organization served a Detroit community(s)?

Please provide specific outcomes derived from a current or past project or program your organization executed to serve a Detroit community(s).

2. What are your project goals?

Please provide a clear project scope and specific goals.

The KIP:D initiative provides grant funding for up to 24-months after receipt of the award. Proposed projects must be time-bound resulting in a clear deliverable or take away at the end of the 24-month grant period, whether they are physical (e.g., building rehabilitation) or non-physical.

3. What community does your project aim to serve and how will your project advance community priorities over the 24-month grant period?

*Please specify the **community** (defined below) that will benefit from the project as well as how community priorities were identified through **consistent, authentic, and inclusive community engagement** (defined below) and how these priorities will be addressed by your project.*

Community can be defined by a shared geography (such as a neighborhood) and/or an identity (such as artists, LGBTQIA, etc.) that community members share.

KIP:D defines community engagement as a process that:

*Builds trust across a broad set of residents and stakeholders through a series of events and outreach;
Empowers stakeholders (residents, local business-owners, surrounding block clubs or neighborhood associations, etc.) to elevate their voices in shaping the project goals; and
Humbly listens, incorporates feedback from engagement and empowers resident decision making to meaningfully inform how a project is designed and implemented **over the 24-month grant period.***
