

What is a neighborhood action agenda?

Over the past 10 years there have been many planning studies and millions of dollars of investment in and around the neighborhoods adjacent to Livernois + W. McNichols. Though some neighborhoods in this area of Northwest Detroit have been historically stable, others are still more exposed to shock. The goal of this Action Agenda is to create a holistic and inspirational vision for stable, healthy, thriving communities that builds off of the existing work of local community organizations.

This is not another plan, but seeks to connect on-the-ground work to the larger vision with a focus on implementation. The boundary of this work is: the Lodge and Meyers (west), 8 Mile (north), Linwood (east), and Fenkell (south). This action agenda will result in a vision, as well as a path to implementation and capacity building for community-elevated neighborhood priorities around categories such as: development, public realm/arts + culture, youth + education, and community wellness + sustainability.




Goals for this initiative:
